



## Family Team Conferencing

Data for Q1, 2016

January 1, 2016- March 31, 2016

### Data Highlights:

- Total number of **FTCs completed** during this period: 108
  - 43 (39.8%) of these were for Non- Judicial cases and 65 (60.2%) were for Shelter cases
  - 107 (99.1%) of these FTCs were planned and facilitated by FTC staff members
  - Of the 43 Non- Judicial FTCs completed, 5 of these were part of the Safety Management Pilot project in Alachua County
  - 34 (23.9%) FTCs were exempt
    - 26 were for Judicial cases, 8 were for Non- Judicial cases
    - Reasons for Exemption:
      - 32% Client no showed to scheduled appointment
      - 29% Family Declined FTC
      - 15% Parent Incarcerated
      - 15% Other
      - 6% Client could not be reached
      - 3% Family resides outside of catchment area
- **Participants:**
  - Average number of attendees is 4 people (including Facilitator and FCC)
  - Average number of non-professional attendees is 2 people
  - This ratio is in accordance with our target that professional participants will not outnumber family supports who attend FTCs
- 196 **unique service types** were authorized from FTCs completed during this period
  - 51% Mental Health
  - 32% Domestic Violence
  - 9% Parenting
  - 6% Substance Abuse
  - 2% Other
- The average number of **calendar days to complete FTCs** was 24.76 days (target is 25 calendar days)
