A Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician will:

- ✓ Check for recalled, expired or damaged seats
- ✓ Make sure the car seat is correct for the child's age and size.
- ✓ Make any needed adjustments
- ✓ Make sure the safety seat is installed securely.

DO YOU NEED A CAR SEAT? If your child's car seat is unsafe, or your child does not have one; new car seats are available for income eligible families at the low cost of \$30. Limit of one seat per child. If you are expecting a baby, please make an appointment 6 to 8 weeks before your due date.
