## Kid's Group

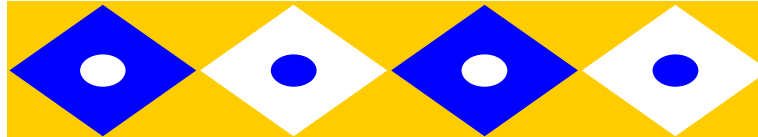
Elementary students are invited to join Peaceful Paths for an interactive group about healthy relationships and coping skills.
