From 2009-2017 data showed a **67%** decrease in **verified maltreatment counts** for the 5 zip codes served by the Alachua County Resource Centers, as compared with a 59% reduction in areas not served by the Resource Centers.

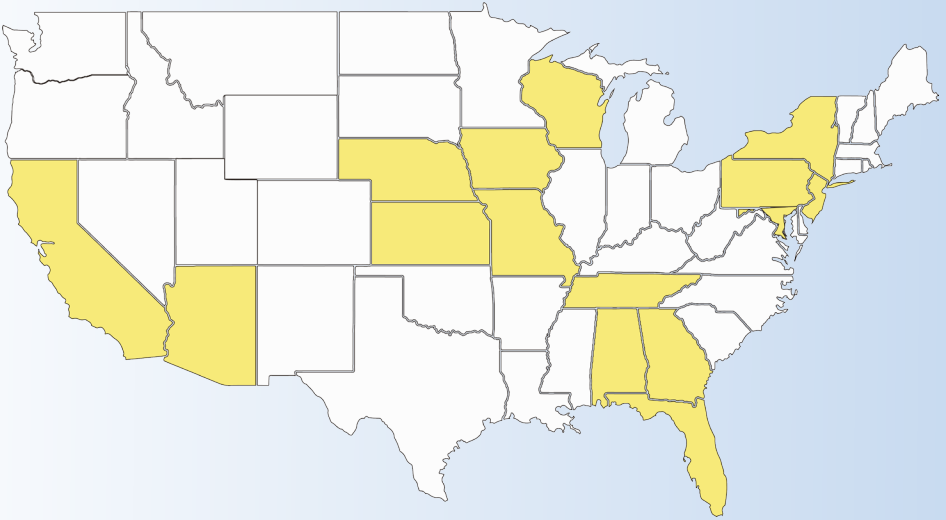

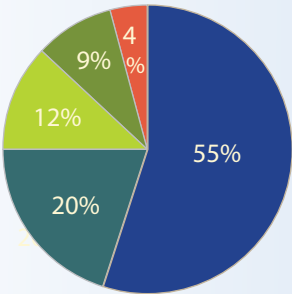


# STATES PSF HAS SHARED OUR RESOURCE CENTER MODEL
