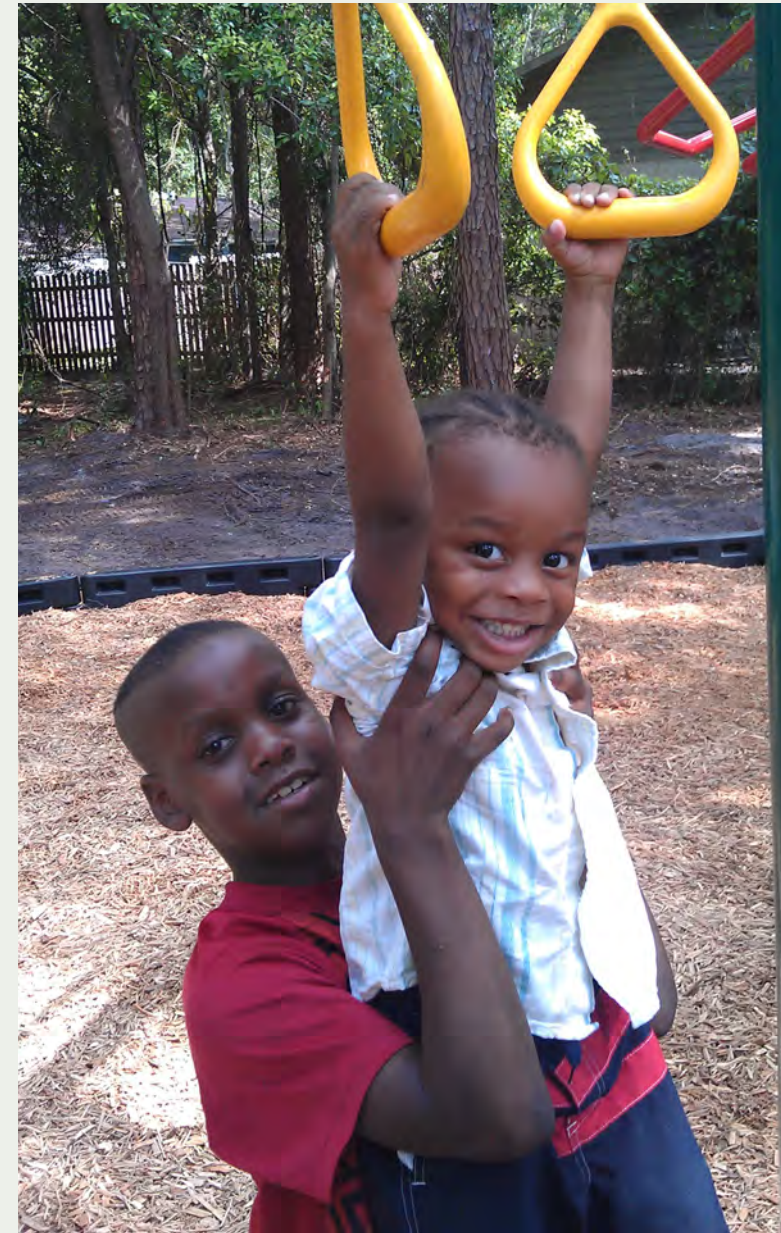

OUR HISTORY

The SWAG Family Resource Center opened in June 2012 to serve southwest Gainesville, primarily the 32607 zip code. The resource center is a collaborative effort between the grassroots community organization SouthWest Advocacy Group (SWAG), Partnership for Strong Families (PSF) and Alachua County.

SWAG is made up of area residents, advocates and service providers that strive to improve the health, well-being and success of residents in the Tower Road area, just west of I-75 in the 32607 zip code in southwest, unincorporated Gainesville. Through access to community resources, health services and educational opportunities, SWAG aims to improve the overall quality of life in its seven neighborhoods, including Majestic Oaks, Linton Oaks, Tower Oaks, Holly Heights/Gordon Manor, Pine Meadow, Harbor Cove and Hidden Oaks.

PSF's Mission is to enhance the community's ability to protect and nurture children by building, maintaining and constantly improving a network of family support services.

OUR GOALS

To partner with SWAG to develop a Family Resource Center that:

Values Children

We will offer services to support the physical and emotional safety and health of children from conception to graduation and beyond. We will promote well-being for every child through the participation and support of their families by providing resources such as health screenings, child development classes, safety information, school readiness programs, tutoring, mentoring and after school and summer activities.

Strengthens Families

We will offer opportunities for families to enjoy and learn from each other by engaging in supportive and educational activities that benefit every member. We will provide services and programs that offer resources and skills beneficial for self-sufficiency, parenting, healthy relationships, problem solving and crisis prevention/intervention.

Engages the Community

We will continue to embrace our partnership with SWAG by continuing to develop ways to connect with the community, build relationships, assess needs

and learn about and grow the existing assets that can improve the overall quality of life in the SWAG area.
