Kids Yoga

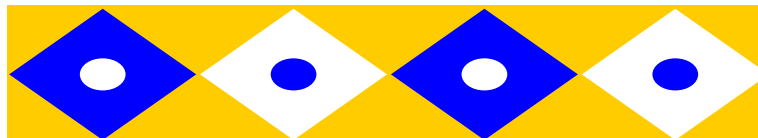
Kids Yoga is specially designed to get kids more involved in physical activity, as well as to develop their focus and relaxation. It's yoga time!!
