## SUPERHERO 5K AIMS TO RECRUIT ADOPTIVE PARENTS FOR LOCAL YOUTH

**GAINESVILLE, FLA** — Partnership for Strong Families (PSF), the lead community-based care agency in North Central Florida working with children who have experienced abuse or neglect, will host its second annual "Superhero 5K" race on Saturday, November 5 at Westside Park in Gainesville. All proceeds will benefit the recruitment of adoptive parents for local children.

The race will begin at 8:30 a.m., with check-in and registration beginning at 7:00 a.m. Participants may also pick up their registration packet at Fit2Run in the Oaks Mall on November 3 from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Registration is \$20 for ages 16 and up and \$5 for children ages 6 to 15. Children under five may join free. Children in licensed foster care with PSF can also register for free. Registration includes a race timing bib for runners, goodie bag and race t-shirt for the first 200 adult registrants. Children's t-shirts can be purchased for an additional \$5.

PSF created this event to increase awareness of the need for adoptive families for local foster youth. The need for teen and sibling adoptions is especially high.

"Every child deserves the gift of permanency but some youth, especially our teens and sibling groups, stand a greater likelihood of having to endure longer waiting periods before being adopted," stated Stephen Pennypacker, President/CEO of Partnership for Strong Families. "We need Adoptive Families willing to open their hearts and homes to our local youth who are hoping to meet their forever family."

Families are encouraged to dress as their favorite superhero for the race. Afterward, participants will enjoy pizza from BJ's Restaurant and Brewhouse, information and giveaways from event sponsors and the chance to meet local children currently available for adoption.
