OUR HISTORY

The Cone Park Library Resource Center opened in December 2013 to serve the Southeast Gainesville community. Cone Park is a collaborative effort between Partnership for Strong Families (PSF) and the Alachua County Library District. It is located within Fred Cone Park, a City of Gainesville park that offers ample indoor and outdoor recreational facilities including the Eastside Recreation Center, a competition-grade track, playground, basketball court and green space.

OUR PURPOSE

Our purpose at the Cone Park Library Resource Center is to empower and strengthen individuals and families by helping them find answers to their questions and connecting them to community resources to meet their needs. Cone Park aligns itself with PSF's mission by providing services and programs to strengthen families and protect children through a system of community supports.

Values Children

We will offer services and programs to support the physical and emotional safety and health of children from conception to graduation and beyond. We will promote the well-being of every child through the support of their family by providing programs such as early learning and enrichment activities, skill building and prevention programs. We will partner with schools to provide educational supports and opportunities for children to connect with others in a supportive environment.

Strengthens Families

We will support the health and well-being of families by providing programs and services that build on their strengths and address their needs. We will offer opportunities for families to learn and engage with one another. Our family-centered services and programs will address self-sufficiency, basic needs, healthy relationships, family resiliency and community supports to avoid and respond to family crises.

Engages the Community

We will partner with agencies, organizations and members of the Southeast Gainesville community to assess community needs, connect individuals throughout the community and provide services that will build on community strengths and needs.
