ALACHUA COUNTY REGISTRATION & VERIFICATION INFORMATION

Holiday assistance for families with children between the ages of 1-12. Registration is open 10/1 - 11/14. You must pre-register **online** and then bring your supporting documents **in person** to have your application approved. All applicants must reside in Alachua County and must provide proof of residency, guardianship, and financial need. Toy pickup will be in Gainesville.

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STEP ONE: APPLY ONLINE

Pre-register **ONLINE** by 11/14 at: <https://newberry-fl.toysfortots.org>



STEP TWO: BRING YOUR DOCUMENTS

Bring the required documents **IN PERSON** to have your request approved.

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STEP THREE: PICK UP YOUR TOYS

Once your application has been approved, you will be assigned a time and date to pick up toys.



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- Government-issued photo I.D.
- Proof of residency, if different from Photo I.D.
- Each child's birth certificate or court ordered legal guardianship documentation
- Proof of current income or proof of government assistance (SNAP, TANF, etc.)
- Application Control Number (sent to you via email upon completion of the online pre-registration form; if you do not see this in your inbox immediately after submitting your pre-registration, check your junk/spam mail folder!)
