To register your children, ages 1-12 years old, please visit <https://newberry-fl.toysfortots.org/> and click **REQUEST A TOY**. After completing the registration, **ALL** applicants must bring required documents to a designated verification location.

Required Documents:

- Government-issued photo Identification
- Current utility bill, lease agreement or other residential identifying information, IF address is different from ID card
- Copy of each child's birth certificate or court orders
- Proof of current income or Government assistance
- Confirmation # from online registration (Control # sent to you via email)

Mondays and Tuesdays: 9am—12:00pm
Wednesday: 11am—1pm
Friday (10/25): 9am—1pm

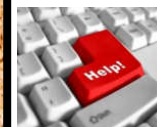
