Required Documents:

- * Government-issued photo Identification
- * Current utility bill, lease agreement or other residential identifying information, IF address is different from ID
- * Copy of each child's birth certificate or court ordered guardianship
- * Proof of current income or Government assistance
- Confirmation # from online registration (Control # sent to you via email)


